FAMILY & DIVORCE MEDIATION TRAINING COURSE

40 HOURS – SUMMER 2018

This forty (40) hour skills development training course is intended to provide law students, lawyers, counselors and others with an understanding of the contexts in which family conflict arises, the various legal and practical issues in play when families disintegrate, and with in-depth training in the skills that a mediator might employ to help the divorcing parties resolve their differences. The training course exposes the participant to relevant factors and normative approaches used by courts in dividing property, determining child support, custody, visitation, and spousal support among other issues, while recognizing that parties in mediation are empowered to reach their own agreements with the aid of the mediator. Role playing exercises are used to integrate theory with practice.

Participants successfully completing this training course are issued Certificates of Completion of Family & Divorce Mediation Training. Rhode Island Attorneys successfully completing the training are also eligible for 20 hours of MCLE credit including 2 hours of ethics credit.

COURSE MEETINGS:

This class will be conducted intensively over five weeks starting on Wednesday, May 23rd and ending on Saturday, June 23rd, 2018. Class meetings are on Wednesday evenings and one whole day on the weekends. The Wednesday evening classes will meet at the Providence campus from 6:00 – 8:30 p.m. (May 23rd, May 30th, June 6th, June 13rd and June 20th). The four weekend whole day classes will meet in Bristol from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. with appropriate breaks (Saturday, May 26th; Saturday, June 6th; Sunday, June 17th; and Saturday, June 23rd). In addition, there may occasionally be some recorded lectures in view on line in between classes.

TUITION & ENROLLMENT LIMIT:

This training course will have an enrollment limited to no more than twenty (16) law students and eight (8) non-law student participants for a total of no more than twenty-four (24). Non-law students are encouraged to register early. The cost of this training course for non-law students is \$1,000. If paid by April 15, 2018, there will be a \$75 discount reducing the cost to \$925.
